

WMRHS Athletic Advisory Committee

A. General

Michael Berry, WMRHS Principal and Kerry Brady, WMRHS Athletic Director are looking to develop an Athletic Advisory Committee for WMRHS. Athletic Advisory Committee membership shall be chosen from SAU 36 Community members living in the school district. WMRHS AAC members will

- Have the opportunity to share suggestions with the Principal and the Athletic Director;
- Assist in finding solution to challenges presented to WMRHS;
- Discuss and evaluate proposed or current initiatives/objectives at WMRHS.

B. Purpose

The Athlete Advisory Committee's purpose is to enhance the total student-athlete experience by promoting opportunity, protecting student-athlete welfare, and fostering a positive student-athlete image.

The WMRHS Athletic Advisory Committee shall give input in planning for the effective and efficient operation of the school district and WMRHS athletic department. The committee will focus on successful school operation which leads to high student achievement and high employee morale.

The WMRHS Athletic Advisory Committee will serve in an advisory capacity only. Committee Members shall communicate to the principal and athletic director issues that have impact on the effective and efficient operation of the school and the athletic department. Offers community members the opportunity to shape the landscape of high school athletics.

In the future, this committee may branch out to serve as the White Mountains Regional School District Athletics Advisory Committee for all WMRSD Schools.

C. Functions

- Promote communication between athletics administration and student-athletes;
- Disseminate information;
- Provide feedback and insight into athletics department issues;
- Have a voice within the athletics department formulation of policies;
- Build a sense of community within the athletics program involving all athletics teams;
- Organize community service efforts.

D. Membership

Selection for this committee will be done collaboratively with the Superintendent of Schools. Community Members who are interested are asked to submit a brief letter to Michael Berry at White Mountains Regional High School stating why they are interested in serving on this committee. Terms may vary in years so that there is an overlap in experience; this will be determined at one of the first meetings.
